On the Thursday morning, we will open at 11:00 AM when we will launch our 2024 studbook. Once again, our Breed is doing magnificent things for the Royal Highland Show with Clydesdales on parade across all 4 days beginning with the judging of males and females at 8:15 AM and 8:00 AM respectively on the Thursday morning.

The Ridden class will be on the Thursday lunchtime start at 13:30 PM, Harness and Decoration on the Saturday at 10.30 am - and don't miss coming along to watch our youngsters in action on the Sunday morning with the young Stockman class beginning at 8.45am and the Clydesdale Young Handler Final from 11:00 AM.
