

Regulations

- 1 All horses listed on the entry form must be the bonafide property of the named exhibitor at the closing date of entries and entries must be signed by the exhibitor or their agent.
- 2 The correct entry fee must be remitted with the form, or the entry will not be accepted for the show catalogue.
- 3 The Organisers accept no liability as to any misrepresentation with regards to the pedigree name or status of any entry made by an exhibitor or their agent or which is inadvertently published in the show catalogue.
- 4 Late entries will be accepted after the closing date. A Late Entry Fee of £15 is to be paid in full by 10am on the morning of the show.
- 5 Public Liability Insurance, for ridden and driving classes, a copy of insurance MUST be enclosed with entry form, and be in the name of the exhibitor. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor/owner to have adequate liability insurance to indemnify the organisers of the event for any claims against death, injury, disease, or damage to an person, vehicle or property arising from or caused by the actions of their horse or rider/driver during any activities carried out in connection with the event. Exhibitors are advised to insure against fire and other appropriate risks as regards to their own property and against third party claims.
- 6 No animal suffering from disease, unsoundness or malnutrition will be allowed to compete and must be removed from the event if the organiser's instruct.
- 7 Protest must be lodged with the event organiser's on the day in writing stating the grounds for the objection with a £20 deposit which will be refunded should the protest be upheld.
- 8 Winners of trophies are solely responsible for their safekeeping and engraving. All trophies are to be returned back to the show no later than 10am on show day, cleaned and polished ready for representing. In the event trophies returned damaged, costs for replacement will be the sole responsibility of the returning exhibitor.
- 9 The organisers reserve the right to refuse or cancel any entry and return entry fee without explanation

RULES TO COMPETITORS

COMMENCEMENT OF JUDGING

Judging commences at 11am in the order of in-hand, riding and driving/agriculture.

IN-HAND SHOWING

It is to be advised that each breed is to be shown in accordance with the relevant breed society standards, which relate to turnout, showing and etiquette. It is not compulsory for horse to have shoes, however, in the event that horses are shod then they must comply with the relevant breed society.

RIDING CLASSES

Class 15 will be ridden as a ridden hunter to follow the rules set out for the Blair Castle Ridden Series Qualifier for the ridden Clydesdales. Two Judges will judge classes 15 & 16, 1 being a ridden judge and the other a conformation judge.

Class 18—Working Equitation all horses that are entered in the ridden section will automatically be entered into this class. Within the activities there will be a small jump, this will be against the clock with a fault scoring system in place for each element.

DRIVING/AGRICULTURE

Extra time and space will be given to those who compete in the driving classes. Appearance money will be paid per horse.

STABLING

Any competitor taking stabling MUST muck out the stable thoroughly prior to leaving the premises. Any damage caused to the stables will be invoiced to the owner of the animal. Bedding and Hay will be provided, however any other must be provided by the owner. The organisers accept no liability for damage to either horse or exhibitors property, whilst using the stabling. In the event of any outbreaks of infectious diseases horses that are to be stabled must produce veterinary evidence of vaccinations being up to date.
