### INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETION OF APPLICATION FORM

Please read these instructions carefully before completing the application form. The old style CHS passport application form has been superseded. Only applications submitted on this form obtained from the office will be accepted.

**Passport applications must be made before the horse is 6 months of age or by 31<sup>st</sup> December in the year of birth (whichever is later). Any applications received outwith these timescales will result in the passport being stamped "duplicate" and the horse will not be eligible for the foodchain.**

**Registrations and Entries as Produce with the CHS require to be made by 30<sup>th</sup> September in the year of birth. Any applications received after that date will be charged a double fee.**

It is important that you write clearly and in capitals as the Outline Diagram will be scanned directly into the passport.

White markings **must** be drawn in red ink. Please use a black pen for the rest of the application. When describing the colour please use normal horse colours. Roans must be described as either Bay Roan or Blue Roan. All markings must be described.

**You must complete** sections 1, Part A – Identification Details, **1 (b), 2(a), 2(b), 3(a) - (h).**

**Your vet must sign and stamp** Section 1, Part B – Outline Diagram. You may complete the markings on the Outline Diagram in advance of the vet visit but it must be confirmed as accurate by the vet and the completed Outline Diagram must be signed and stamped by the vet.

If the horse has no markings (solid colour) and has less than 3 whorls, then you must complete the Chestnuts Section. In each corresponding box you need to outline each chestnut on the horse's legs.

Incorrectly completed forms will be returned to the breeder and an administrative charge of £10 applied so please take care to ensure the form is completed correctly.

All filly foals must be DNA tested.

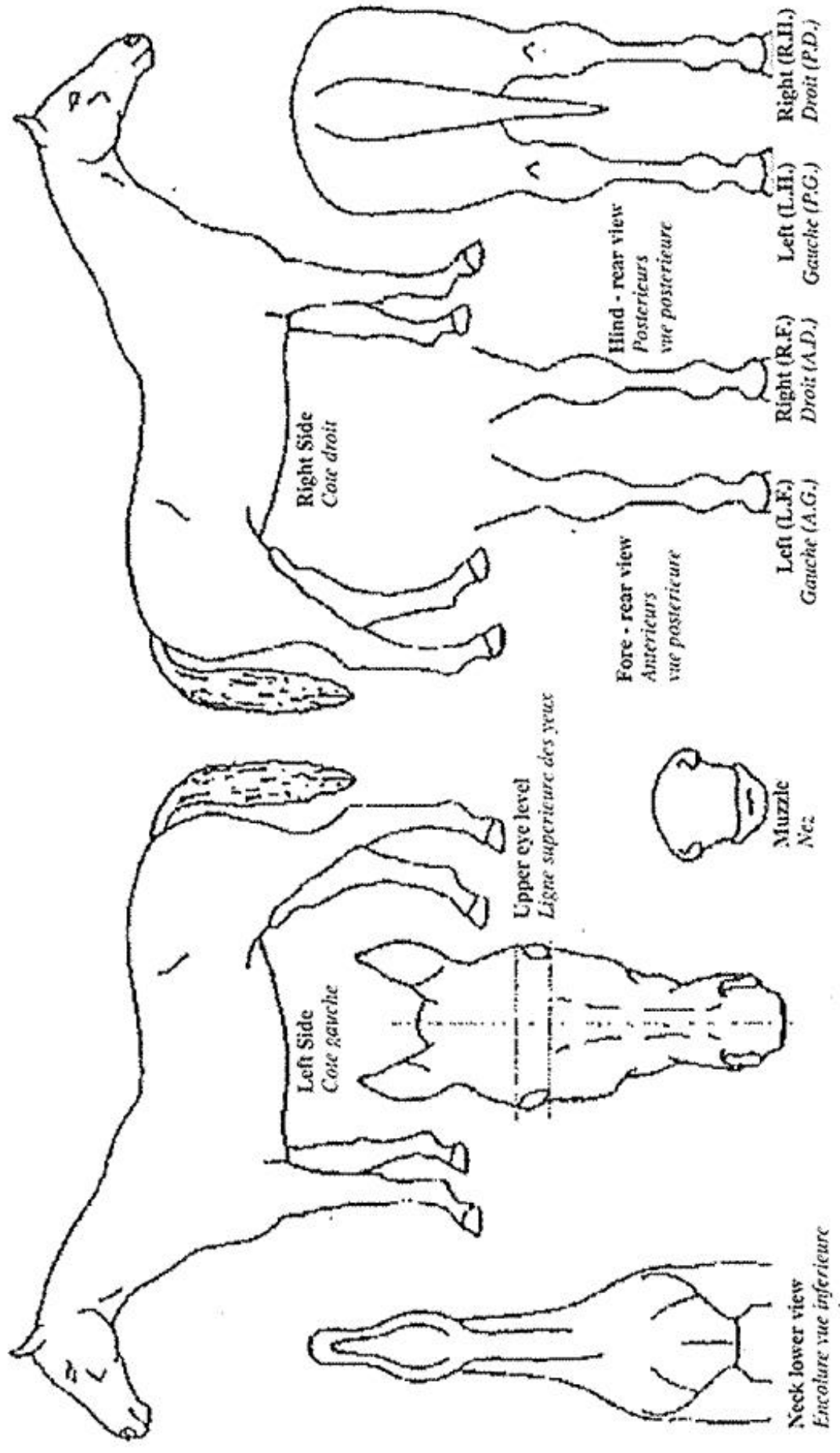
